QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for a parking permit a student must:

- 1. Have a valid operator driver's license. Learner's permits are NOT accepted.
- 2. Proof of valid vehicle insurance.
- 3. Complete the 2024-2025 Student Parking Application in its entirety including having the form notarized.
- 4. Must be enrolled in grades 10-12.
- 5. Have a 2.0 GPA or higher.
- 6. Be cleared of all school obligations.
- 7. Purchase a parking decal from the BCPS e-Store \$60 fee ONLINE ONLY.
- 8. CONFIRM THAT YOU MEET ALL QUALIFICATIONS PRIOR TO PURCHASING A PARKING DECAL

REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES

- 1. Parking permits will be provided on a "First Come-First Serve" basis. Once all spaces are filled, no additional permits will be available.
- 2. Once issued, parking decals cannot be altered or transferred to another vehicle.
- 3. Parking decals must be always displayed and visible on the front driver's side windshield while on campus.
- 4. Loitering in the parking lot is prohibited. After entering the parking area, all students must leave their cars immediately and report to their designated area and remain on campus.
- 5. Cars are not to be used as lockers. Students should return to their cars only when leaving school at the end of the day or after signing out in the Welcome Center.
- 6. Students are to park in designated areas only. There is no parking on the grass, faculty/staff areas, or in visitor parking.
- 7. Parking permits will be revoked if removed from vehicles for any reason other than surrendering it to school administration.
- 8. School Board Policy 5307... "The Board shall not be responsible for damage to motor vehicles parked or operated on school property."
- 9. A new parking decal MUST be purchased if a parking decal is lost or stolen. This includes students changing vehicles during the school year.

CITATION/SUSPENSION/REVOCATION MAY OCCUR IF

- 1. A student fails to register a vehicle with administration.
- 2. A student has excessive unexcused absences or tardies from campus, leaves campus with authorization and/or takes other students off campus without prior approval.
- A student exceeds the 5 mph speed limit in the parking lot and/or engages in reckless driving within the perimeter of the school grounds.
- 4. A student transfers, sells or receives a legal, illegal or fraudulent parking decal
- 5. A student parks in unauthorized areas.
- 6. A student's vehicle displays words or graphics that are offensive and/or disrupts the school environment.
- 7. A student is in the parking area without a proper pass.
- 8. A student does not have a current signed Student Code of Conduct form on file in Student Affairs.
