CAMBRIDGE PROGRAM

Deerfield Beach High School is a Cambridge School. You can take AICE classes to work toward earning your Cambridge Diploma. Successfully earning a Cambridge Diploma with 100 service/work hours qualifies you for Full Bright Futures Scholarship. Within a 3 year program candidate must earn a minimum of seven credits (taking the course and passing the corresponding exam). There are four Cambridge subject groups and one compulsory course called Global Perspectives AS level. The candidate must earn credit in at least one from subject groups 1-3 and Global Perspectives AS Level. The other 3 credits may come from subject groups 1-4, with a limit of 2 credits from subject group 4. All Cambridge course names start with the acronym AICE and are 6 point courses for weighted GPA.

You can take AICE classes even if you are not pursuing the Cambridge Diploma.
