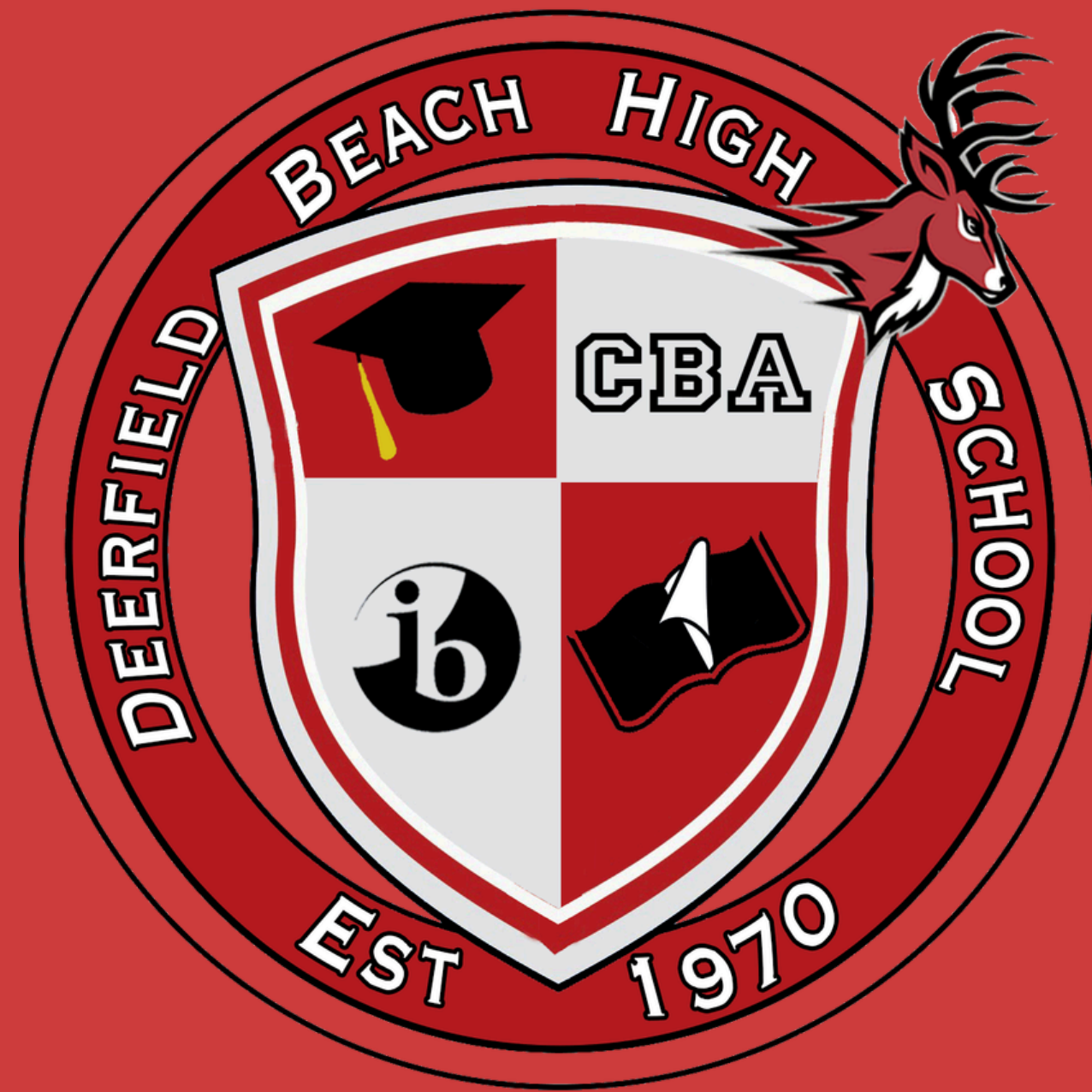
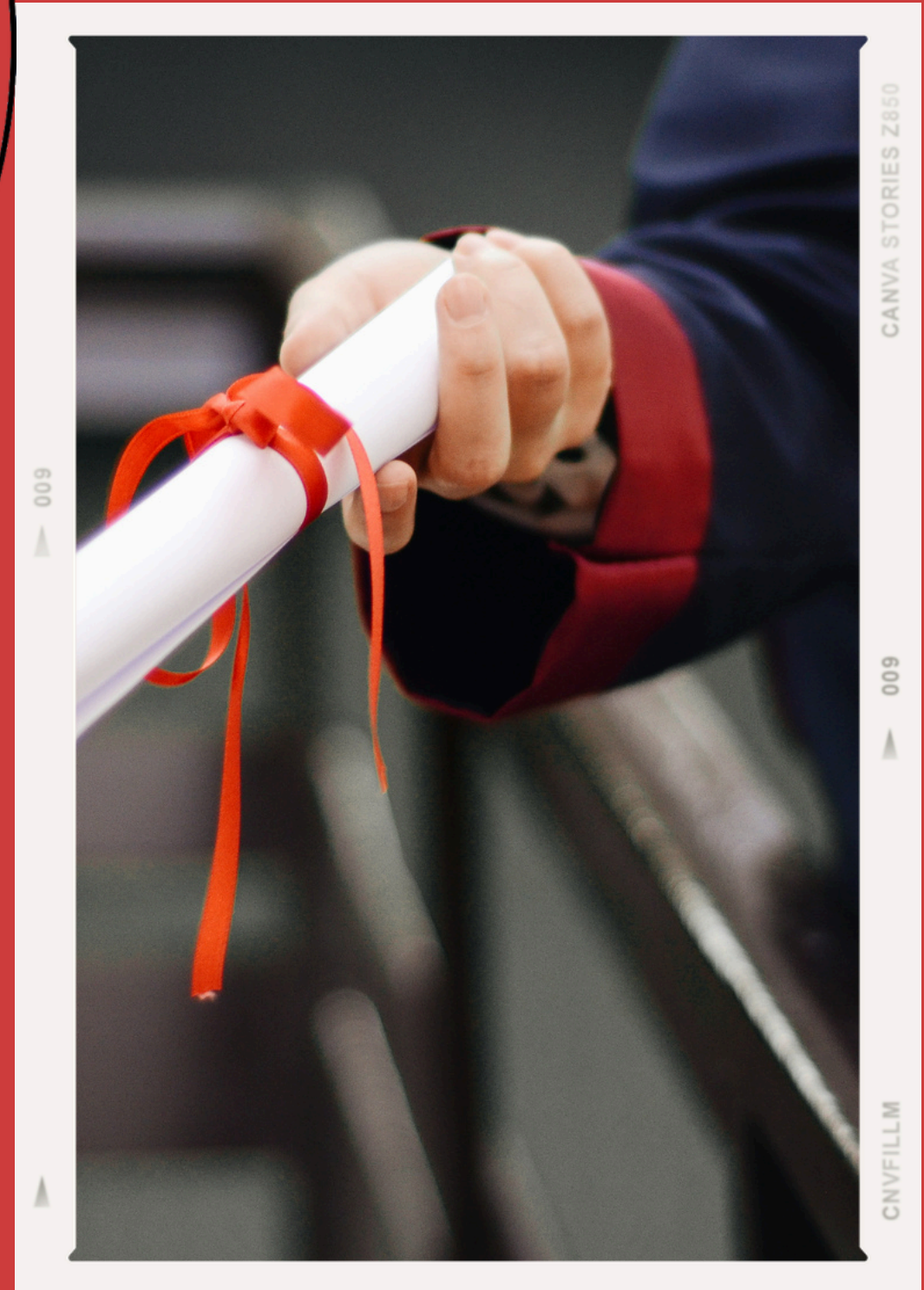

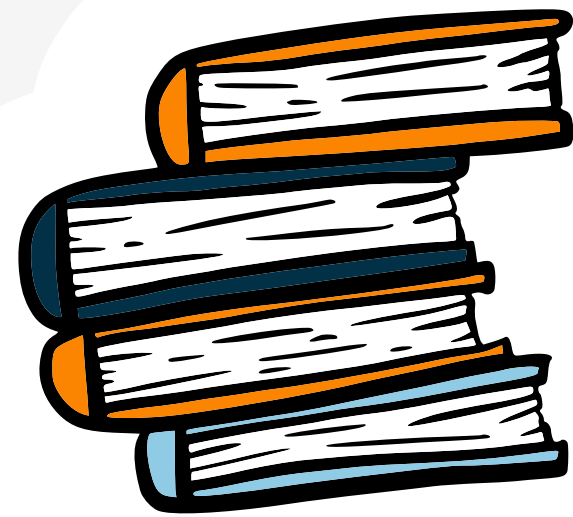

No one will be admitted after 9:00pm

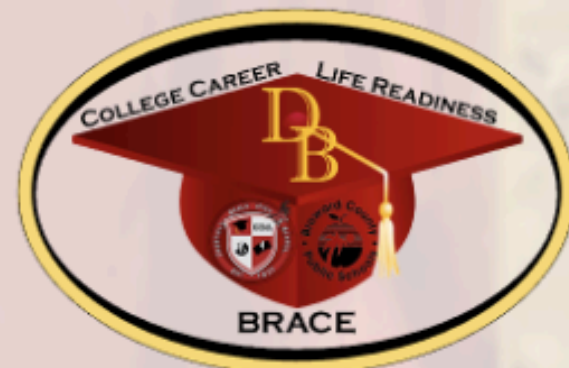
In order for guests to enter Prom, they must be accompanied by a DBHS Senior, purchased a ticket, and turned in a permission slip form

## Ladies:

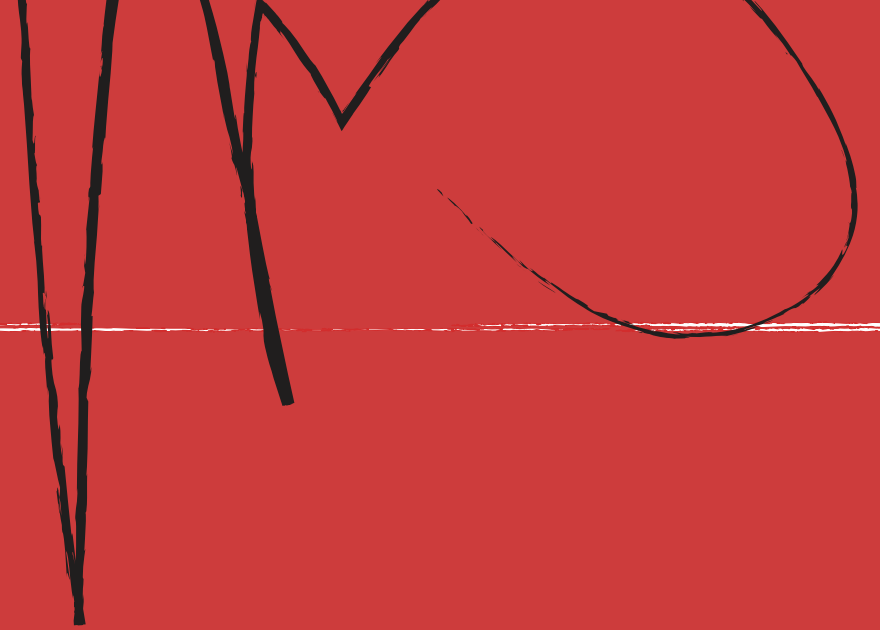
- Black shoes

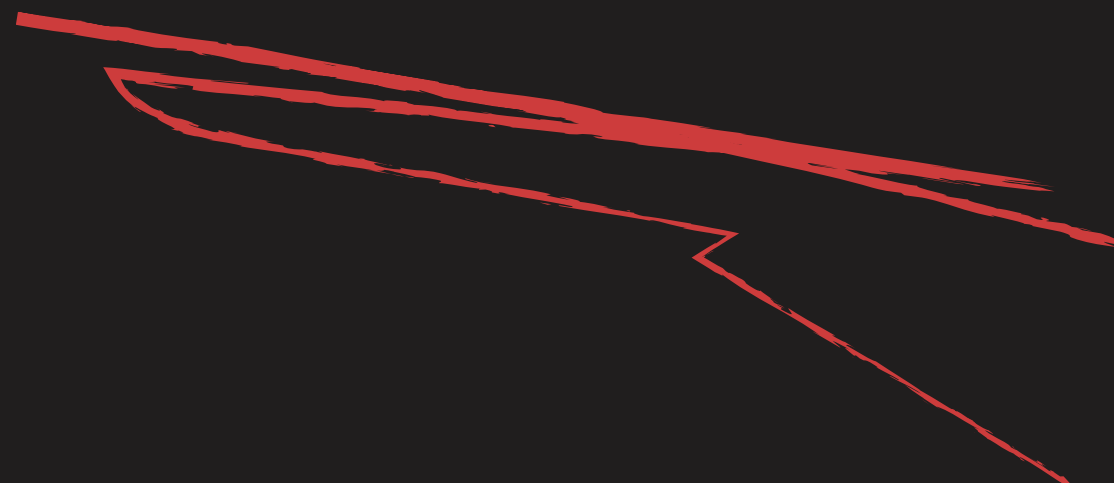
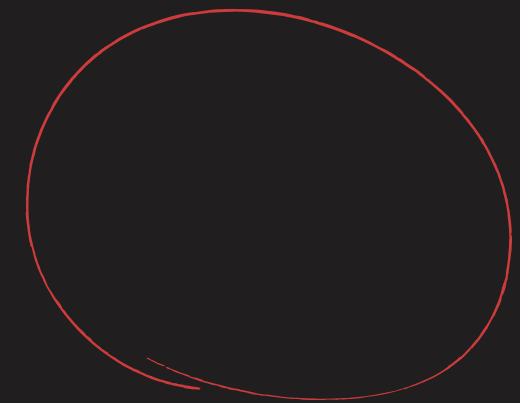
